









ARKA Art Gallery carries out its activities in Saint-Petersburg since 2004. The gallery opened its doors in a new room on Bolshaya Morskaya Street, 6, very close to the Arch of the General Staff at the Palace Square with exposition area - 160 m. The exhibition "Against the Current", organized jointly with the Latvian gallery "Basteis" with the support of the Consulate General of Latvia in St. Petersburg was the first one. Over the years, the gallery has implemented out more than 200 projects on its territory and on other art venues, Including in various state museums of Siberia, in the Consulates General of Latvia, Lithuania, Great Britain, actively promoting the work of artists of St. Petersburg.

One of the most successful projects was the travelling exhibition "Petersburg", exhibited at the Novosibirsk State Art Museum, the State Art Museum of the Altai Territory (Barnaul) and the Tomsk Regional Art Museum (2008). Not less popular were the original exhibition projects of the ARKA gallery, such as the "Easter Kaleidoscope" (2008-2013).

In 2010 the gallery received the Diploma of the Nevsky International Ecological Congress for this project presented at the Tavricheskiy Palace, the headquarters of the Interparliamentary Assembly of the Member Nations of the Commonwealth of Independent States at the Third Nevsky International Ecological Congress of the IPA CIS, the Council of Federation of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation with the support of the Government of the Russian Federation. For the years of its activity, the gallery has been the organizer of festivals (Italian and Japanese art, etc.) and actively participated in international and city festivals (Master Class, Autumn Photo Marathon, ARTINDEX, Japanese Spring in St. Petersburg, Biennale Design "Modulor", Saint-Petersburg International Carnival, "Artesaniya", "Unforgettable Crafts", "Traditions and Modernity", etc.).
